Easy Sensory Snow

Baking soda

Water

optional: glitter (blue works great), peppermint essential oil.

A great indoor activity during the cold winter months is sensory play. An easy way to make some fake snow is to mix a whole box of baking soda with a little bit of water. Just add a little at a time until it starts to stick together. You can add some glitter to make the snow sparkle (just be cautious so they don't rub it in their eyes) or some essential oils like peppermint for a great smelling activity. Add arctic animals or cars to expand on play.
