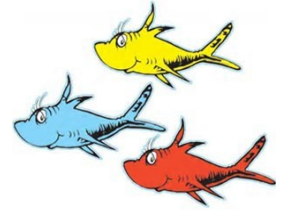




# March

Mendel's Munchkins!

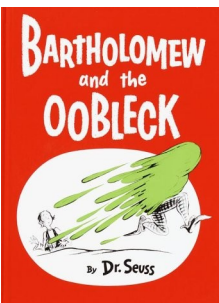

- 2 Cups Cornstarch
- 3 Drops Food Coloring
- 1 Cup Water
