Learning in November:

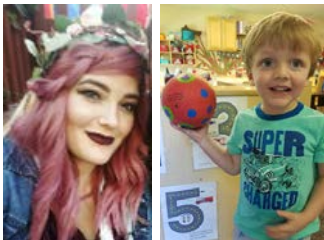
